








These are some social media apps with the language teaching functions.

Apart from social media, Blogging is also a good way to help students in their learning journey.

According to a research from a Doctor of Education Vurdien (2013), blogging can be used to enhance the writing skills of Spanish students who are learning English as a second language.

Instructors can use blog-based peer responses to enhance the writing skills of students. Students will benefit from blog-based peers when tackling higher level revisions.





But why?

Scholar Ducate and Lomicka (2005) explained that It is because during writing the blog, Students can gains the skills to appreciate and uptake the better traits of writing, as well as to avoid making mistakes or errors which might be deemed inappropriate in their compositions.

Also, teachers can use the blogs he wrote to understand their writing style and his writing strengths and weaknesses. While Blogging can facilitate creativity, experimentation and ownership. Blogging allowed students to express themselves in the relaxed environment.

Problem of blogging

Many blogs are abandoned when boredom characterizes the readers or writers. This weakness can disadvantage the student or instructor if blogging is the main tool being used to learn or teach the language





Writing Wikipedia is another approach that has attracted the attention of scholars as tool to be used in learning process.

Wikipedia could be used to adopt language learning and identity. The research carried out by Kuteeva (2011) also noted that Wikis could be used to change the relationship between the writer and reader. After studying several wikis written by students, the author noted that these resources confirm the interaction between a writer and reader. They raise awareness of the audience and increase the utilization of interpersonal discourse. King (2015)





Problem of Writing Wikipedia

One of the unique weaknesses relates to their vastness, as indicated by King (2015). Although this characteristic can be advantageous, it can limit the effectiveness of these resources because a student might feel intimidated or unsettled if they realize that they will be displaying their second language writing skills on such public platforms.





Technologies have their affordances and constraints

When students choose to use specific approaches such as blogs or wikis, they also expose their strengths and weaknesses. Instructors and students should be motivated by what works best for the student in question where considerations related to the environment, learning levels, among others, should be the focus.
